The meeting was called to order at 5:30PM by Tyler Bauer, Chairman

Approval of Minutes:

The minutes from January 9, 2025 meeting were reviewed.

Old Business:

Chairman Bauer presented the Resolution to rename the Awalt Bridge, which had been tabled at the previous meeting. Mayor Chris Guess shared feedback from residents, both in favor and against the renaming. He recommended keeping the name as Awalt Bridge, citing the presence of several military veterans in the community. Chairman Bauer called for a motion to approve sending the Resolution to the County Commission, but no motion was made, and the matter failed.

New Business:

1. **Approval of Resolution requesting the 114th Session of the Tennessee General Assembly Allocate One Half of the Real Estate Transfer Tax to the County where the Tax was collected on a recurring basis.**

Mayor Chris Guess presented a resolution to the committee. If the County Commission approves it, the resolution will be sent to our legislators for consideration. The goal is to pass

House Bill 842 and Senate Bill 843, which would allow the County to receive half of the realty transfer fees on property purchases.

• Motion made by Schultz to approve Resolutions a-g. Second by Summers. All Ayes. Motion carried.


