

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Franklin County, Tennessee will hold a public meeting at 2:00 p.m., Monday, January 30, 2023, in the small conference room of the Franklin County Administration Building to discuss the Community Block Grant (CDBG) Program administered by the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the guidelines of the program and to solicit input from area residents regarding potential uses of CDBG funds. 2023 CDBG funds can be used for water system improvements, sewer system improvements, and housing rehabilitation. Additionally, community development projects are eligible including public health and safety (ambulances, fire trucks, clinics, EMS stations); community infrastructure (streets, drainage, flood mitigation); and community revitalization (community centers, daycares, etc.).

All residents or entities with projects are encouraged to attend this meeting or mail suggestions to County Mayor, Franklin County Administration Building, 855 Dinah Shore Blvd, Winchester, TN 37398.
